AN ACT TO: To fix and make safer main roads for the state of New York

The People of the State of New York, represented in the Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

PURPOSE:

 To increase jobs and fix roads for the state of New York

SUMMARY OF PROVISIONS:

Section 1:

- (1) Most accidents on the road occur with big semis or construction trucks. We would like more construction workers to work on the roads so more people don't get into accidents they don't cause.
- (2) There are a lot of people suffering in financial cost for their damaged car or medical bills. If more people are hired then those things will not happen.
- (3) It might cost a lot financially but if it saves a lot of lives we think that it is worth it.

JUSTIFICATION:

It cost about \$1.7 thousand per person in their lifetime for either medical bills or damaged cars. And also 20 million are injured or disabled per year in the U.S. 18 million of those are with car crashes. So if we hire more people to fix and make the roads safer this wouldn't happen that often. It cost about \$130 per pothole about 2 feet by 2 feet. It cost about \$300 per filling crack about 6 feet by 2 inches. If more people get hired to fix roads less people will end up in a dramatic situation such as a car crash not caused by other vehicles. We could higher taxes and give that money to the government to have them make the roads safer.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:

This will cost the government about \$305 thousand(305,000) to make the roads of New York safer and better.

EFFECTIVE DATE:

32 This bill shall go into effect in about 2 years after it passes.
