- 19 2.) All weather news channels will send out an alert to all fire halls when a tornado touches the ground, and then fire

22 JUSTIFICATION:

- 23 The reason this should become a law is to reduce death rate statewide due to tornadoes. New York must be ready for
- these types of situations, but this needs to be standardized for that to happen. New York averages 5 tornados per
- 25 year, so why take the risk because climate change will just make the situation worse?
