13 violation punishable by a fine of not less than twenty five nor more than one hundred dollars a
14 \$100 , repeat offenders are subjected to the revoking of their livery license.

16 **JUSTIFICATION:** In the last 3 years, there have been approximately 60 fatalities and 300
17 accidents in New York State due to boating accidents. In the summer of 2016, there was a major
18 motorboating accident on Lake George. The result was the death of an 8 year-old girl. This
19 accident also heavily injured the girl's mother. The intention of our bill is to limit these types of
20 accidents and to require boat liveries to mandate boater safety courses to be able to rent
21 motorized water vessels.
