10 Purpose

- 11 The purpose of this bill is to repeal all of the new york state standardized tests for
- 12 elementary and middle school students. The classes whom would repeal the
- 13 standardized tests are english, mathematics, and science.

15 Summary of Provisions

- 16 <u>Article 7 A</u>
- 17 <u>Article 7 B: Standardized testing shall hereby be illegal under this provision.</u>

19 Justification

- 20 Many students feel as if that the stress and workload of taking these tests is too 21 much for students in elementary school and middle school. By taking away these
- tests, it will enable students to focus on their school work instead of these tests.

24 Fiscal Implications

29 The bill will go into effect in September 1, 2018.
