- 5 The People of the State of New York, represented in the Senate and Assembly do enact as follows:

6 **Purpose**

- 7 Create a state holiday to memorialize those who lost their lives due to the 9/11
- 8 attacks.

9 **Summary of Provisions**

- 10 Section 1: Definitions
- 11 9/11: Series of airline hijackings and suicide attacks committed in 2001 by 19
- 12 militants associated with the Islamic extremist group al-Qaeda against targets in
- 13 the United States, the deadliest terrorist attacks on American soil in U.S. history.
- 14 <u>Awareness</u>: Knowledge or perception of a situation or fact.
- 15 <u>Section 2</u>
- 16 § 24. Public holidays; half-holidays. The term public holiday includes
- 17 the following days in each year: the first day of January, known as New
- 18 Year's day; the third Monday of January, known as Dr. Martin Luther
- 19 King, Jr. day; the twelfth day of February, known as Lincoln's birthday;
- 20 the third Monday in February, known as Washington's birthday; the last
- 21 Monday in May, known as Memorial day; the second Sunday in June, known
- 22 as Flag day; the fourth day of July, known as Independence day; the
- 23 first Monday in September, known as Labor day; the 11th day of September,
- 24 <u>known as 9/11 Memorial Day.</u> the second Monday in October, known as Columbus
- 25 day; the eleventh day of November, known as Veterans' day; the fourth
- 26 Thursday in November, known as Thanksgiving day; and the twenty-fifth day of
- 27 December, known as Christmas day, and if any of such days except Flag day is
- 28 Sunday, the next day thereafter; each general election day, and each day
- 29 appointed by the president of the United States or by the governor of this state
- 30 as a day of general thanksgiving, general fasting and prayer, or other general
- 31 religious observances. The term half-holiday includes the period from noon to
- 32 midnight of each Saturday which is not a public holiday.
- 33 (NY CONSOLIDATED LAW, General Construction, Article 2, Section 24)
- 34 <u>Justification</u>:
- 35 This will aid in commemorating this historically significant date as its significance
- 36 should be relayed to future youth, allowing its impact to never be forgotten.
- 37 Fiscal Implications
- 38 There would be fiscal implications, as public schools, would get off, with private
- 39 schools being an exception.
- 40 Environmental Implications
- 41 There are no environmental implications in our bill
