Amend § 4405-a of the New York State Public Health Law to allow for individuals 16
years of age to get vaccinated without parental consent.

The People of the State of New York, represented in the Senate and Assembly do enact as follows:

9 Purpose

- 10 Allow for individuals 16 years of age to get vaccinated without parental consent.
- 11

12 Summary of Provisions

- 13 <u>Section 1: Definitions</u>
- 14 Vaccine: A product that stimulates a person's immune system to produce immunity
- 15 to a specific disease, protecting the person from that disease.
- 16 <u>Section 2</u>
- 17 § 4405-a. Immunizations against poliomyelitis, mumps, measles,
- 18 Diphtheria and rubella.
- 19 1. It shall be the duty of the administrative
- 20 Officer or other person in charge of each health maintenance
- 21 Organization, as defined in this article, to inquire of each person in
- 22 Its care under the age of eighteen, or of a person in parental relation
- 23 To such person, whether all necessary immunizations have been received
- 24 For poliomyelitis, mumps, measles, diphtheria and rubella and, if not,
- 25 To make available such immunizations and a certificate or certificates
- 26 Of such immunizations.
- 27 2. This section shall not apply to children whose parent, parents, or Guardian are
- 28 bona fide members of a recognized religious organization
- 29 Whose teachings are contrary to the practices herein required Minors that are 16
- 30 years of age or older are eligible to receive vaccines without parental consent.
- 31 3. If any physician licensed to practice medicine in this state certifies that any
- 32 such immunization may be detrimental to a child's
- 33 Health, the requirements of this section shall be inapplicable until such
- immunization is found no longer to be detrimental to the child's health.

36 Justification

- 37 Every year we see in the media that more and more people aren't getting
- vaccinated. We need to act now if we want to stop this "movement" in its tracks.
- 39 People may use beliefs to justify the detrimental effects of vaccinations as a means
- 40 to argue that they should be exempt from vaccines, however, vaccines have been
- 41 proven to not have many negative effects. Most vaccines are needed to attend
