The People of the State of New York, represented in the Senate and Assembly do enact as follows:

Purpose: the purpose of this bill is to protect the political rights of workers with certain political beliefs/affiliations.

Summary of Provisions

Section 1. Definition

Political beliefs and affiliations are defined as a registered Democratic, Republican

or any political party. Viewpoint of such political parties or association with such

Section 2. The opportunity to obtain employment without discrimination because of age, race, creed, color, national origin, sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, military status, sex, marital status, disability or <u>political beliefs and affiliation</u> is hereby recognized as and declared to be a civil right.

<u>Justification</u>
